CHAPTER 2

COUNTY ORDINANCES – EXEMPTION

APPLICABILITY

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of Keedysville are the duly constituted legislative body for the Town of Keedysville, Maryland, a municipal corporation, existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Maryland, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Keedysville has been authorized and empowered pursuant to Article 23A of the Annotated Code of the Public General Laws of Maryland, 1957, as subsequently amended, to specifically exempt itself from applicability of county ordinances and/or legislation; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Keedysville through its duly authorized body does hereby desire and intend to exempt itself from the applicability of County Legislation of the County of Washington in accordance with the provisions of said Article 23A, 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED, that The Mayor and Council of Keedysville does hereby declare itself, pursuant to Article 23A, B, of the Annotated Code to be specifically exempt from any and all Washington County Legislation within the corporate boundaries of said Town, EXCEPT:

- 1. Those Ordinances already adopted by the Town which are Washington County Ordinances, or
- 2. Those Ordinances which the Town by Ordinance has requested and authorized Washington County to administer or enforce within its corporate boundaries as of this date; and
- 3. Except any other Washington County Legislation which is specifically provided for as being applicable with the corporate boundaries of The Town of Keedysville under Article 23A, B, of the Annotated Code of Maryland.
