

KEEDYSVILLE PLANNING AND ZONING

MEETING October 10, 2011 7PM

The minutes from September's meeting were read and approved.

Old Business: The shed structures that were alleged to be housing humans were determined to be baseless. The issue is that a shed has been erected that did not have a permit.

Permits: Johnny F. Starlipper, 82 S. Main Street, wants a permit for a shed. It is 21' x 11', vinyl siding, no electric. This is the structure mentioned in Old Business above. Patsy Starlipper was present to answer questions that arose from the Committee. Not addressed in the drawing were the setbacks from the property line. Ms. Starlipper was told this information must be given to Rick. It was determined to recommend to Rick to issue the permit once Ms. Starlipper provides setback information.

Washington County Highway Department, 6223 Coffman Farms Road, wants a permit to erect ridged lifeline fall protection. Butch Yurish was present at this meeting to answer questions that arose from the Committee. This safety lifeline will protect workers when they are working on top of the trucks. It will consist of a 6' x 6' x 4' concrete foundation on the north side of the building and at same angle as the gas island. It will be 26 feet high and galvanized. Dave made a motion to approve, Don seconded. All agreed.

Randy read an informational letter from MDE concerning money that is available to communities to develop a plan to protect water sources from contamination. The assessment has already been completed and Rick will be contacted.
