David Brumage gave NO Parking information as received from the State, documenting no parking zones. Report was somewhat confusing and needs to be clarified through the State. David Brumage will continue to work with the State to complete.

Mary Robertson reported that a member of the community may be interested in doing some grant writing for the new town hall committee.

Dan Johnson from Bulb Electric was present to go over park lighting, after discussion lighting was agreed on and ordered.

Mary Robertson made a motion to donate \$100. to the senior citizen center at the Old School for their craft budget, Richard Walton 2<sup>nd</sup> all agreed. Motion passed.
