Bids for the basketball court overlay were reviewed a motion was made by Barry Levey and 2^{nd} by Richard Walton to award bid to Remsburg Family Partnership.

A motion was made to install 2 speed humps on Taylor Drive to slow down traffic by Barry Levey and 2^{nd} by Rob Smith.

Mayor Hull discussed the plans to install a new sidewalk within Taylor Park; work will move forward to gather bids for project.

A request for an amendment to the Livestock Law was voiced by Town Resident Marci Jastrab. After much discussion, Mayor Hull advised that the Town would take the next 30 days to gather facts from Town Attorney and other residents on the possibility. Issue would be reviewed at next month's meeting
