Council members were reminded that current Refuse Collection contract would expire in January 08. Current contractor is currently interested in re-bidding.

Bulk pick-up for residents was approved and pick up will be Saturday the 13<sup>th</sup> of November.

The police patrols that are apart of the OT have been very successful and will continue.
