

October 6, 2014

The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Water Commission was called to order at 8:56pm, with the following members present: Commission Chairman Barry Levey, Commission Members Matt Hull, Victoria Gudeman, Gina Ellis and Ken Lord and Town Administrator Rick Bishop.

Minutes for September, 2014 were read and approved.

General Fund Report was \$147,155.54

Mr. Bishop said that he had met with Dave Kline from Potomac Edison and that the town was currently paying the lowest electric rate available at the booster pump station and water tank.

Mr. Levey noted the purchase of radio read meters to continue the replacements.

Mr. Levey suggested that we do a leak detection in the spring, after the next 100 meters have been replaced.

Mr. Levey made a motion to move 50%, or approximately \$150,000 from the Water Tap Fees account to a long term account to provide future funds for maintenance and painting of the water tank. Ms. Gudeman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
