

November 7, 2011

The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Water Commission was called to order at 8:10pm, with the following members present: Commission Chairman Barry Levey, Commission Members Matt Hull, Richard Walton and Tim Robertson and Town Administrator Rick Bishop.

Minutes for October 3, 2010 were read and approved.

General Fund Report was \$108,734.39.

Regarding the infrastructure upgrades Mr. Levey noted:

- the water tank was being filled;
- the desire by the town to include recirculation pumps for the water tower in the USDA agreement;
- the possibility of putting a generator at the water treatment plant and who would pay for it;
- the results of leak detection on Main St. being only two leaking hydrants.

The need for an operation agreement for the water storage tower and the booster pump station was discussed. Mr. Levey made a motion to move ahead with the proposed agreement for operation of the water storage tower and booster pump station with Washington County. Mr. Hull seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Gina Ellis asked the commission to discuss how the new valves on Main St. would affect future repairs and shut offs. Mr. Levey replied that it depends on the location in town as the south end of town has some loops in the system but the north end does not.

Meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
