

# Apple Valley Waste Schedules & Guidelines within the Corporate Limits of Keedysville

## Schedule

**Trash pickup:** Every Monday morning

**Yard waste pickup:** Every Tuesday morning (Pickups are suspended January, February & March.)

**Recycling pickup:** Every Thursday morning

**Bulk Pickups:** There are two bulk pickups each year, one on a Saturday near the end of April & one on a Saturday near the end of October. The exact dates will be noted in those months' newsletters.

**\*\*\*For all pickups, please have all materials curbside the evening before the pickup day.\*\*\***

## Recycling Guidelines

See additional sheet. (Please note that while Apple Valley is no longer recycling glass, if glass is mixed in with your other recyclables, they will still take them.)

## Yard Waste Guidelines

Yard waste must be contained in a biodegradable paper bag or tied in bundles not to exceed 4 feet in length and 35 pounds in weight. If biodegradable paper bags are unavailable or sticks and twigs cannot be bundled up please place the material in a regular trash container for pickup. NO PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS. Each Bag, can or bundle of material cannot exceed 34 gallons in size and 35 pounds in weight. Any material that is contaminated with trash will be left. Acceptable materials include: Grass, Leaves, Weeds, Sticks, twigs, small limbs and branches under 3 inches in diameter.

## Bulk Trash Guidelines

Please put items curbside Friday evening for Saturday morning pickup. Unacceptable items include the following:

- paint – unless it is completely dried out
- soil, rocks, sod, tree trunks, limbs, or stumps resulting from tree removal
- parts of motor vehicles
- Poisons, acids, caustics, gasoline, oil and other flammable substances, explosives, ammunition, or other hazardous or dangerous materials
- bricks, blocks, concrete in any form
- contractor's waste materials
