The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Water Commission was called to order at 7:32, with the following members present: Commission Chairman Barry Levey, Commission Members Ken Lord, Gina Ellis, Judy Kerns and Matt Hull and Town Administrator Rick Bishop

Minutes for March, 2020 were read and approved.

General Fund Report was \$208,803.26.

Mr. Bishop gave an update on the Antietam Waterline project. He noted that the ROW across the railbed has been approved, but due to COVID-19, a signed deed has not been received. He noted that the Maryland DNR did grant the Town a right-of-entry so the construction could begin. He said the materials list had been provided by Core & Main to Fred Frederick. He said Mr. Frederick had a few questions regarding the project that he hoped the Town could respond to soon.

Mr. Bishop noted that the fire hydrant at the end of Antietam Drive was now active.

Mr. Levey noted a valve on North Main Street by the park that cannot be turned.

Ms. Ellis asked about the tank maintenance contract. Mr. Levey said it would be advertised in the next week or so.

Mr. Levey noted the tank inspection done by Freeman Industries.
