Old Business

Water Line Replacement RFP - Mr. Sweeney presented an estimated budget for this project over the next 10 years. There was much discussion. Mr. Sweeney is not in favor of moving forward with this project at this time. There was mention of using the ARPA funds for preventative maintenance. There is potential for other grant money to assist with the water line replacement. Ms. Riner reported that Mayor Lord has set up a meeting with Maryland Rural Development Corporation. They may be able to assist with grant writing.

Asset Inventory - The Army Corp of Engineers is still working in Boonsboro and hasn't gotten to Keedysville yet.

Meter Radio Towers – The Town of Boonsboro has reported this project is on the back burner for now.

New Business

Water Access Across 34 – Ms. Riner brought up property for sale across Rt 34 and who is responsible for getting water to that property. There was an interested buyer in this property. Ms. Baker suggested this be figured out for future potential buyers. How much is on the Town vs. the property owners? The owners of the property would be responsible for the tap fee, but there was mention that the Town might be responsible for getting the pipe to a certain distance from the property. The Council will look into this further.

Leak at Hydrant/Pump in Park – Ms. Riner reported the plumber found a leak at the bottom of the hydrant/pump in the Park. This was repaired during the process of running water to the pavilion.
