Advertising & Social Media – Discussed the need for a Mission Statement and to start posting general information to the Green Team Facebook page to help generate interest and awareness.

Solar Panels on Library – Ms. Pangle reported things are moving forward with the solar panels and roof replacement. Ms. Riner put the solar panels out for bid on October 17 and the roof replacement out to bid on October 18.

He will reach out to them to see if they are available. Ms. Pangle will contact the man from Shepherdstown about glass recycling. Mr. Wiegand will reach out to a contact he has in Frederick for recycling electronics. Ms. Lord mentioned doing a raffle to give away a rain barrel or compost bin. Mayor Lord said this may be something the Dept of Ag has ideas and/or resources to help. Discussed doing a Business Directory and Resource Center on the website and Facebook page. Ms. Pangle will send examples from Burkittsville's website promoting local business/resource centers to Mr. Wiegand. Chairman Russell talked about information he found on the Lantern Fly and how to report it. This is the type of information worth posting on the Facebook page. Many ideas were discussed for the Spring Festival. It's a matter of reaching out to see who is available. Everyone agreed to the date of April 29, 2023, from 10 am-3 pm.
