## **Green Team Minutes January 31, 2023-special session**

The special session of the Keedysville Green Team was called to order at 7:02 pm with the following present: Chairman Jeff Russell, Mayor Ken Lord, Team Members, Evan Wiegand, Sandy Lord, Kathy Hoffman, and Administrative Assistant Teresa Pangle.

This was a special meeting to discuss the April 29<sup>th</sup> spring event and the purchase of subsidized compost bins and rain barrels for the community.

There was some discussion about changing the date of the spring event due to an event in Boonsboro on the same day, or possibly joining the Boonsboro event. It was discussed if we keep the event low key we can stick with the original date of April 29<sup>th</sup>. It was discussed to see if we could arrange a bulk trash date a few days after April 29<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Pangle will contact Apple Valley Waste. It was agreed to keep the April 29<sup>th</sup> date, and have the community yard sale, compost bins/rain barrels, sports swap at one of the pavilions, and possibly a food truck. It was suggested to do a flyer to go in the water bill. It was mentioned the community yard sale and sport swap should start around 8 am. Signs can be put out to advertise the yard sale and sports swap.

There was a discussion about the compost bins/rain barrels and doing them on the same day as the spring event or doing them on a separate day of their own. There was discussion regarding the pros/cons of doing a pre-sale vs bulk order and how much if any the Town will subsidize. The information will be presented at the next Mayor and Council meeting for them to decide.

There was a brief discussion about applying for certification with Sustainable Maryland and where we are with points.

Mayor Lord asked to modify the Mission statement to remove one of the two "sustainable" words. Mr. Wiegand agreed.

It was agreed to move our next meeting from February 16<sup>th</sup> to February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Meeting adjourned at 8:03 pm.
