### Old Business

Business Directory – Mr. Wiegand reported he was able to login, but has not had a chance to work on the directory.

Chesapeake Bay Trust Grant/Compost Bins & Rain Barrels – Ms. Pangle reported Ms. Gratton has submitted the grant to Chesapeake Bay Trust and we hope to hear something in early April.

Eagle Scout Project – Ms. Pangle spoke to Mr. Franko. He doesn't feel planting trees in the park meets the criteria for the Eagle Scout project. Ms. Pangle suggested a food forest project and Mr. Franko seemed interested. Ms. Pangle emailed him the Sustainable Maryland guidelines. Mayor Lord mentioned plantings around the new gazebo (once completed) as a potential Eagle Scout project.

Spring Launch – Mayor Lord reported Ms. Gemeny with the Ruritans agreed to run ice cream from Nutters out of the Town's pavilion. He suggested making a donation to the Ruritans since he believes the ice cream will be free. Ryan Lord was here on behalf of the National Honor Society to offer volunteers to aid the event. Mayor Lord has a 10x30 tent the volunteers can help set up the night before. It was agreed to have the volunteers from the National Honor Society come to Town Hall on April 26<sup>th</sup> to make posters/signs for the event. Ms. Lord mentioned there will be face painting, a kids' craft, and possible seed plantings. Mayor Lord suggested getting a map of the park to help determine where to place people, food trucks, etc. Mayor Lord said there are potentially two more musicians but there might be a fee attached. He will follow up with them. Mayor Lord also mentioned Mr. Riner is a musician and wondered if he was interested. Ms. Pangle will check with Ms. Riner about this. There was a discussion about placing signs and advertising on Facebook for the community yard sale. Mayor Lord mentioned there may be someone who can demonstrate alternative power sources. Those details are still being worked out. There was a discussion about getting t-shirts for volunteers. Mayor Lord will follow up on t-shirts and purchase the markers and poster board needed for signs. Mayor Lord will bring the PA system that was bought for the 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Chairman Russell suggested contacting the Hera d-Mail to cover the event. Mr. Wiegand will advertise the community yard sale as a separate event on the Cannon Ridge and Rockingham

Facebook pages and update the flyer. It was determined to have an additional meeting on March 30th before our next scheduled meeting on April 20<sup>th</sup>. The volunteers will come on April 26<sup>th</sup> to make signs and then a final meeting on April 28<sup>th</sup> to set up tents/signs etc.
