Chesapeake Bay Trust Grant/Compost Bins & Rain Barrels – Ms. Pangle reported Ms. Gratton has submitted the grant to Chesapeake Bay Trust and we hope to hear something in early April.

Eagle Scout Project – Ms. Pangle spoke to Mr. Franko. He doesn't feel planting trees in the park meets the criteria for the Eagle Scout project. Ms. Pangle suggested a food forest project and Mr. Franko seemed interested. Ms. Pangle emailed him the Sustainable Maryland guidelines.
