NOW THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** that Chapter 23 as it currently exists be and is hereby repealed in its entirety; and be it further

RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED that Chapter 23, an *Ordinance Establishing Fees and Charges for Licenses, Permits, and Administration Fees of Governmental Functions* be and is hereby enacted, adopted, re-enacted, modified and/or amended as specifically set forth in **Exhibit A** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and it is further

RESOLVED, ENACTED and ORDAINED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution and any other documents necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 23 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR LICENSES, PERMITS, AND ADMINISTRATION FEES OF GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS

1. AUTHORIZATION

This Amended Ordinance is enacted and authorized pursuant to the general police power of municipalities and the provisions of the Maryland Constitution Article XI, the Charter of the Town of Keedysville, and the provisions of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of the State of Maryland.

2. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The complexity and expense connected with the administration of municipal government necessitates the adoption and update of a standard and uniform schedule of fees to be collected by the Municipality in order to defray the costs of administration pertaining to licenses, permits, land development review, and all other applicable municipal functions.

3. APPLICABILITY

The fee schedule set forth herein is in addition to and not in derogation of any fee, administrative expense, requirement of the Subdivision Ordinance of the Town of Keedysville, or of any other ordinance, act, statute, or regulation of the Town or any other governmental agency.

This Amended Ordinance applies only to the fees and schedules enumerated herein as follows:

Infrastructure Improvement Plans:

All infrastructure improvement plans shall be reviewed by and approved by the Town's Engineering Consultant and/or Washington County Engineering Department at the sole expense of the Developer. The Developer shall place funds into an escrow account controlled by the Town equal to the Consultant's estimate of costs. At the completion of the review, the Developer shall be invoiced for any deficit in the account or shall receive the remaining balance of said escrow account.

The term "Developer" shall include a fee simple owner of the property in question and the contractor or sub-contractor engaged to perform the work.

Inspection of Improvements:

All new public infrastructure facilities constructed shall be inspected by the Town's Construction Services Consultant and/or Washington County Government at the sole expense of the Developer. The Developer shall place funds into an escrow account controlled by the Town equal to the Consultant's estimate of costs. At the completion of the construction and the

acceptance of infrastructure when satisfactorily completed, the Developer shall be invoiced for any deficit in the account or shall receive the remaining balance of said escrow account.

The term "Developer" shall include a fee simple owner of the property in question and the contractor or sub-contractor engaged to perform the work.

Ordinances Administered by Washington County, Maryland:

Administration of certain Ordinances has been delegated to Washington County and is the responsibility of Washington County, Maryland, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code. The County, in essence, administers the following Keedysville Ordinances and regulates same:

Chapter 4: Building Codes, Permits, and Inspections Ordinance

Chapter 5: Grading Ordinance
Chapter 6: Floodplain Ordinance
Chapter 7: Conservation Ordinance
Chapter 8: Storm Water Management

In addition thereto, the Town of Keedysville is serviced by sewer from the Washington County Sewer Department and system. This is administered by Washington County.

Fees, expenses, permits, plan reviews, and/or any other costs connected directly or indirectly shall be paid directly to the appropriate agency for Washington County, Maryland. Reviews and approval are subject to all Federal, state, county and other acts, ordinances, and regulations.

- (b) Fees or sums collected under development agreements with developers and/or builders or any other persons, firms or corporations or entities;
- (c) Fees regulated by another ordinance either of the Municipality or Washington County, or the statutes or regulations of the State of Maryland or any other governmental agencies;
- (d) Connection fees;
- (e) Charges, expenses, fees, bonds, and other matters required by the Subdivision Ordinance and/or any other applicable ordinances;
- (f) Annexation agreements in effect and/or that may be entered into in the future.

5. <u>CONFLICT</u>

In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Amended Ordinance and the provisions of any other ordinance or resolutions establishing or amending the fees to which this Amended Ordinance applies, the provisions of this Amended Ordinance shall govern.

6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

If any section, subsection, sentence, phrase or portion of this Amended Ordinance is held to invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Amended Ordinance.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this Amended Ordinance shall become effective on the 27th day of September, 2022. The current provisions of Chapter 23 shall remain in full force and effect until said Effective Date.

RESOLUTION ENACTING CHAPTER 23 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF KEEDYSVILLE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR LICENSES, PERMITS, AND ADMINISTRATION FEES OF GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS

RECITAL

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Keedsyville. Maryland as its duly constituted legislative body have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizenry of the Town of Keedysville to establish certain administrative permit fees for the orderly administration of clerical matters within the geographical confines of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Enacted. Resolved and Ordained that an Ordinance entitled Chapter 23, an Ordinance Establishing Fees and Charges for Licenses. Permits, and Administration Fees of Governmental Functions be and is hereby enacted and adopted as follows:

CHAPTER 23 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR LICENCES, PERMITS, AND ADMINISTRATION FEES OF GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS

1. <u>AUTHORIZATION</u>

This Ordinance is enacted and authorized pursuant to the general police power of municipalities and the provisions of the Maryland Constitution Article XI, the Charter of the Town of Keedysville, and the provisions of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of the State of Maryland.

2. PURPOSE AND INTENT

 - (t) annexation agreements in effect and/or that may be entered into in the future.

5. CONFLICT

In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and the provisions of any other ordinance or resolution establishing or amending the fees to which this Ordinance applies, the provisions of this Ordinance shall govern.

6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

If any section, subsection, sentence, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is held to invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

7. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective on the 14 day of NOURWOLA, 2004.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ENACTED and ORDAINED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution and any other documents necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
