Green Team Minutes April 18, 2024

The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Green Team was called to order at 7:01 pm with the following present: Team Members, Mayor Ken Lord, Sandy Lord, Evan Wiegand, Jason Krebill, and Administrative Assistant Teresa Pangle.

The minutes from March 21, 2024, and the April 4, 2024 work session were approved.

Old Business

2024 Spring Event – Ms. Lord reported the Master Gardeners would not be attending due to unforeseen circumstances. There was a discussion about relocating some of the presentations away from the music pavilion and potential parking locations. Mayor Lord said he would bring his 2 pop-up canopies and he purchased a 3rd one for the Town to buy. Mayor Lord will take the keys to unlock the picnic tables and move some tables into the grass. Mr. Wiegand will email Ms. Pangle the PDF of the flyer/map to print for Saturday. Ms. Lord said she would take flyers to the soccer field on Saturday morning. Mr. Wiegand has a friend who might take drone footage of the SpringFest. Mr. Krebill mentioned (if not this year, next year) having the vendors provide a sign to put out at Taylor Dr and Rt 34 to advertise they are at the event.

Potomac Valley Planting Project in Taylor Park – Ms. Pangle reported Ms. Thomas will have a sign-up sheet for this project. Ms. Thomas would like to do the planting on June 1st.

Vain St/Rt 34 Railbed Lease Update – No updates.

Rail bed Cleanup Update - Ms. Pangle reported Mr. Johnston with DNR does not see a problem with this, but wants to confirm with Mr. Hulse who is the land unit manager for this area. We should hear something by the end of this week or early next week.

Spring Community Yard Sale Date/Bulk Trash – There was a discussion to post the Community Yard Sale Flyer next week after SpringFest is over and the bulk trash the following week. Mr. Wiegand will post Boonsboro's

Swap & Recycling Event before posting the Community Yard Sale/Bulk Trash pickup. This gives people an opportunity to recycle items before being sent to the landfill.

New Business

Boonsboro Green Team Invitation – Boonsboro is having a Green Team Organizational Meeting on May 1st. Mr. Hunninghake, Director of Sustainable Maryland will be on hand to answer questions.
