A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Town of Keedysville – Parking of Vehicles – Restrictions**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from parking certain vehicles in the Town of
4 Keedysville, Washington County; and generally relating to the parking of vehicles in
5 the Town of Keedysville, Washington County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 21–1011.

15 (a) (1) This section applies:

16 (i) To a vehicle registered or capable of being registered:

17 1. Other than under § 13–917 of this article, as a Class E
18 (truck) vehicle under this article;

19 2. As a Class F (tractor) vehicle under this article;

20 3. As a Class G (trailer) vehicle under this article;

21 4. As a Class H (school bus) vehicle under this article; and

1 5. As a Class P (passenger bus) vehicle under this article; and

2 (ii) Only in [the]:

3 1. THE Town of Sharpsburg, Washington County; AND

4 2. THE TOWN OF KEEDYSVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY.

5 (2) This section does not apply to any vehicle that is of a type capable of
6 being registered:

7 (i) As a Class A (passenger) vehicle under § 13-912 of this article;
8 or

9 (ii) As a Class E (truck) vehicle under § 13-917 of this article.

10 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person may
11 not park a vehicle on any street or highway.

12 (2) This subsection does not apply if the parking of the vehicle is essential
13 to the immediate use then being made of the vehicle.

14 (c) (1) In the case of a combination tractor and trailer, a person who violates
15 this section is subject to a separate fine for each vehicle.

16 (2) For the purpose of determining the penalty under this section, each day
17 of a violation is a separate offense.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2024.
