Old Business

Contest for 250th/SpringFest 2026 – The team decided submissions are due by Friday, March 27th, and winners will be notified by Friday, April 17th. All entries will be on display, and the top 3 projects for each grade level will be highlighted. Awards will be presented on May 2nd at 1 pm. Contest information will be sent out to schools after the Green Teams' January meeting on the 15th. The contest will be mentioned in the Town newsletter and posted on social media. All entries will receive the 250th commemorative medallion. All winners will receive a certificate and a 3D printed planter with a plant. 1st place winners in Pre K- 5th will receive \$25, and 6th-12th will receive \$50. All 2nd-place winners will receive a \$15 Nutters Gift Certificate, and all 3rd-place winners will receive a \$10 Nutters Gift Certificate. Mr. Wiegand will create a flyer to go with the contest cover sheet.

2025 Sustainable Maryland Grant Update – No word yet from Sustainable Maryland on the grant winners.

New Business

Promote Watershed Grant Opportunities – The team discussed promoting this opportunity via social media starting in January. Mr. Wiegand will create a flyer to encourage interest.

Odie and the Country Band – They would like to perform at SpringFest for free. They only ask to be allowed to set out a tip jar and sell their merchandise, and that we promote them for the event. The team agreed this was fine. We need to confirm if musicians from previous years are interested in this year.

March Speaker – We have two presentations available from the Wildlife Habitat Advisors Program from Frederick County. The team decided for March to do “Why Planting Natives is the Best Thing You Can Do for Your Garden” and at the September meeting do “Bird Migration the Atlantic Flyway”.

Comments by Team – There was discussion about having a community board at Town Hall, either inside or out, to advertise upcoming events.

The team discussed more craft-type vendors for SpringFest this year. Ms. Pangle will look at vendors that participate in Boonsborough Days. Ms. Lord will check vendors at a Shepherdstown event she is going to this weekend.
