The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Water Commission was called to order at 8:26 pm with the following present: Mayor Ken Lord, Assistant Mayor Brandon Sweeney, Council Members Judy Kerns, Matt Hull, Sarah Baker, Town Attorney Ed Kuczynski, Town Administrator Lisa Riner, and Administrative Assistant Teresa Pangle.

Lead Service Line Inventory – Ms. Riner said that to satisfy the requirements of the service line inventory, there are about 133 lines that are unidentified, and she would like to get them identified before the next deadline. Whatever is not identified at that time becomes part of a replacement plan requiring a lot more work. She received a quote from EADS. They would look at the photos we have, do mailers to the remaining customers, and do site visits as necessary. The quote assumes they will have to do about 40 site visits. They will document the photos, update the inventory, and update GIS. Mr. Sweeney questioned one of the stipulations regarding coordination with MDE. Ms. Riner will confirm with EADS. Mr. Hull motioned to approve the EADS proposal, Ms. Kerns seconded, and all voted in favor.
