Green Team Minutes April 16, 2026

The monthly meeting of the Keedysville Green Team was called to order at 7:00 pm with the following present: Chairman Jeff Russell, Team Member Evan Wiegand, and Administrative Assistant Teresa Pangle.

The minutes from March 19, 2026, were approved.

Old Business

SpringFest 2026 – Ms. Pangle mentioned council member Judy Kerns would like to attend SpringFest to promote her Voices of Keedysville idea. It was agreed she could set up at a table under Pavilion #2. Ms. Pangle contacted Catoctin Land Trust to see if they would like to attend SpringFest. They were very interested, and the team agreed they could set up under Pavilion #2 as well. Ms. Pangle will pick up the gift certificates from Nutter's and have Ms. Riner print the checks for the first-place winners. Mr. Wiegand will create the certificates for first, second, and third place winners. Mr. Wiegand purchased five SpringFest yard signs he will stake around town. We will put up the large banners at Town Hall and Taylor Park. Ms. Pangle reported the Ruritans are getting the ice cream from Potomac Street Creamery in Boonsboro instead of Nutter's. One of the deciding factors was they will deliver the ice cream the morning of SpringFest. The Ruritans will provide eco-friendly bowls, and we still have eco-friendly spoons from last year.

Pollinator Palooza – Chairman Russell said he can attend, along with Ms. Lord. This event is on June 13th at the AG Center. They request vendors start setting up by 8:30 am.

New Business

Vote on Contest Winners – Because of the low attendance at the meeting, we did not have the results for the contest. Ms. Pangle will verify the voting results with Ms. Lord tomorrow. The team agreed the kids did an awesome job, which made voting tough.

SM Green Team Stories – Ms. Pangle reported that Sustainable Maryland is celebrating its 15th anniversary. They have requested that municipalities share testimonials and photos from our certification efforts throughout the years, as well as our logo and links to our website and social media. They would appreciate

receiving the responses by April 30th. I asked the team if they wanted me to forward the four questions from SM to gather their input. Mr. Wiegand and Chairman Russell recommended that I provide the information SM asked for. A lot is happening with the contest voting and SpringFest in two weeks.

Comments by Team

Chairman Russell asked what was going on with the multi-sport court. Ms. Pangle said they have started, and it should be done by the end of summer.

There was a discussion about the 15 S Main St lot and planting around the multi-sport court. Ms. Pangle said Catoctin Land Trust, along with DNR, can help with both areas. Regarding the 15 S Main St lot, they can remove invasives and plant natives, but they can't use money to remove the asphalt/concrete on the lot. Ms. Pangle reported the Town Council agreed to look into quotes to have it removed but would like to see a concept drawing from Catoctin Land Trust. Ms. Pangle mentioned she is meeting with Anna Twigg from DNR on May 15th to look at these areas. While here, she will also look at the trees we planted in Taylor Park last year.
